

Online Sexual Harassment Compliance Training

YUFLI Spring Semester 2016

Learning objective(s): Foreign Instructors (non-Koreans) will participate in an online training course as part of Yeungnam University policy for compliance regarding sexual harassment at the workplace. The participants will be exposed to three types of sexual harassment and will be asked to identify and distinguish between them. Participants will also need to recognize which steps are required by a witness, complainant and/or the offender should allegations of sexual harassment occur. There will be a summative assessment afterwards and participants will need to score at least 80% to be considered compliant.

Assignment due date: The date for completion will be one week (Monday June 13th midnight 12 AM SEOUL time) finals week. The whole process of the compliance training is estimated at an hour if uninterrupted.

Submission details: the assignment can be viewed and completed via the Yeungnam University Blackboard LMS and the link will be provided once available. These instructions will be written in Word, PDF and in html. Instructions for the course will also be contained within the training program.

Scoring criteria/rubric: Since this is a compliance test, 80% accuracy will be required and multiple attempts for compliance will be allowed.

Level of group participation: This will be an individual assignment taken at the time and place of each participant's choice.
